GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.152 dated 31.8.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 506,, 451, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 30.4.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant & affected/aggrieved persons have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant & affected/aggrieved persons have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that the compromise is genuine and with the free will of the parties and without any pressure or coercion from any corner.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.152 dated 31.8.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 506,, 451, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
