Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Asman Singh Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad submits that in consequence of interim order dated 14.09.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and does not oppose the grant of bail though the same has sought to be opposed by Mr. Shiv Kumar, learned counsel for the complainant on the ground of heinousness of the offence.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.09.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
