Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.35 dated 30.03.2019 under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhadson, Patiala.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, submits that during the course of investigation, since the deceased was pregnant, offence under Section 316 IPC has also been added in the case.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to file a fresh petition by incorporating all sections, so pointed out by learned State Counsel.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as aforesaid.

In case, fresh petition is filed within a period of 10 days from today, interim granted by this Court vide order dated April 25, 2019, shall remain in force.

However, on expiry of the said period, interim will cease to operate.
