Petitioner-complainant Hardeep Singh has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to conduct a fair investigation in matter pertaining to FIR No. 174, dated 26.12.2016, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, and to refrain from getting multiple inquiries conducted.

Having perused the petition, this Court finds that the petitioner had lodged the FIR way back in the year 2016, wherein allegations have been levelled to the effect that the accused had cheated the complainant of an amount of ₹ 42,50,000/- on the pretext of sending him abroad. It is averred that the police is resorting the multiple inquiries and has not filed a

final report so far. The petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.3) to dispose off representation dated 22.3.2019 (Annexure P-8) (although addressed to Director General of Police, Punjab) to ensure that the investigation is concluded expeditiously so that final report is filed thereafter at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-8 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.3) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
