In the present writ petition, petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to take a decision as per law with regard to the payment of outstanding dues/arrears of salary for which she is entitled for, after the revision of the pay scale and other benefits, which are yet to be released to her.

As per the averments made in the writ petition, there was an anomaly in the pay scale of Craft Teachers and the said anomaly was removed after the Craft Teacher Welfare Association filed a writ petition bearing CWP No. 19032 of 2012, titled as ***Craft Teacher Welfare Association Versus State of Haryana and others*** (Annexure P-1), which came to be decided on 30.04.2018.

As per the averments made in the writ petition, though the arrears were to be paid to the members of the Association, the same have

not been released to the petitioner. Only a sum of ₹85,000/- has been paid to the petitioner without giving any detail of the amount as to under which head the same has been paid. Petitioner had made representation dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-2), wherein a claim of ₹10 lacs has been made by the petitioner from the respondents as outstanding dues. The said representation is still pending consideration with the respondents as per the averments made in the writ petition.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
