The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.165 dated 11.07.2018 under Sections 323, 506, 498-A and 406 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar.

Vide order dated 10.09.2019 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 24.09.2019.

A report dated 19.11.2019 has been received from the Mediator along with settlement/agreement dated 19.11.2019 which is signed by the parties along with their respective counsel.

Taking into consideration the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide settlement/agreement dated 19.11.2019, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 31.08.2018 passed by this Court, whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that the parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the agreement/settlement dated 19.11.2019 in its letter and spirit.
