Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.67 dated 15.11.2018, registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the FIR, allegation is in respect of committing fraud of Rs.60 lakh on the basis of agreement to sell.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 20.02.2019. She is only to face the trial. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes. The trial of case may take a long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
