In the present writ petition, petitioner is claiming the benefits in respect of the service which her late son, namely, Chandan Mohan rendered before he was murdered on 18.08.2018. The claim of the petitioner that she is the only legal heir, who is entitled for the benefits after the death of her son in respect of the service rendered by Chandan Mohan with the respondents-Police Department.

In the writ petition, petitioner has prayed that she had made representation to the respondents on 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) for the grant of the said benefits to her and the said representation is still pending, therefore, direction be issued to the respondents to decide her representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the averments made by the petitioner in the petition, the interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
