The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No.37, dated 03.07.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and offence under Sections 325, 326 IPC added later on arising out of FIR No.58, dated 03.07.2018, registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the FIR is the outcome of a sudden quarrel between the parties in which injuries were received by both the sides. He further states that the co-accused Harjinder Kaur has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-55846-2018 on 01.05.2019.

This Court, by the order dated 02.05.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 02.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
