Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners claiming the re-fixation of their pay in view of the orders of this Court passed in CWP No. 16084 of 1997 and CWP No. 4518 of 2000, which were upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 08.12.2015. (Annexure P-5).

From the averments made in the writ petition, it transpires that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served upon the respondents a legal notice dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) and as per the averments made in the writ petition, the said legal notice is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice

by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioners in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioners are entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to them within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
