Petitioner has challenged the order dated 26.05.2015 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Batala, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person.

It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner was out of country and, therefore, he did not come to know about the proceedings. He has further pointed out that pursuant to the last order passed, petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been granted bail. In support thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced order dated 15.05.2019 passed by the Judicial Magistrate.

One of the purpose for declaring person proclaimed offender is to secure his presence. Petitioner has already appeared and released on bail.

Accordingly, order dated 26.05.2015 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Batala is set aside.

Petition is disposed of.

Petitioner is directed to appear regularly before the trial Court.
