Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the instant application has become infructuous as the payment in lump-sum has already been made and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

CRM-M-38024-2016

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.65 dated 10.09.2016, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the compromise has already been effected between the parties and the payment in lump sum has been made. He has further submitted that a petition under

Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed which is pending before the court below. He has placed on record the copy of the said petition. Same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 22.10.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
