Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.280 dated 19.12.2018 under Sections 379-B, 34, IPC, Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 18.01.2019. The investigation is complete and the challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner is involved in heinous crime and therefore, does not deserve concession of regular bail. He has further submitted that the prosecution is to examine 11 witnesses.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of

personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
