On 24.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioners are present in person. They claim to have got married on 17.04.2019 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 11. Respondent No.4, who is mother of petitioner No.1, is present in the Court. She requested to the Court to permit her to meet petitioner No.1.

Accordingly, petitioner No.1 and her mother (respondent No.4) had a brief meeting in the Court. Petitioner No.1 states that she does not wish to stay with her mother and she is happily married with petitioner No.2.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

Sh. Jagmal Singh-respondent No.6 (Taya of petitioner No.1) who is present in Court, accepts notice.

List on 02.05.2019.

In the meantime, respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, is directed to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners after examining threat perceptions. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to

protect the petitioners from legal action for violating of law, if any, committed by them.

The Registrar General of this Court is directed to communicate the order immediately to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2.

A copy of this order, under the signatures of Special Secretary attached to this Bench, be given to the petitioners.”

Thereafter, in order to protect petitioner No.1, petitioner No.2 was directed to deposit Rs.2,00,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1 in the nationalized bank. As per the receipt produced, the amount has been deposited in Punjab National Bank, Christian Hospital, Jagadhri. The photocopy of the receipt is taken on record. The petitioners who are present in Court, however, expressed their apprehension to the life and liberty.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar is directed to examine the threat perceptions and take appropriate steps in this regard.

In view thereof, the petition is disposed of.
