FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 11.10.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Jaspal Singh, victim Kamaldeep Kaur and the accused namely Pardeep Singh the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Learned counsel for the private respondents No.2 and 3 as well as learned counsel for the accused/petitioner have made statement that as per instructions received, the parties had given final effect to their agreement settlement/compromise (Annexure P2) and that final effect be given to this petition.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the offenses for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.11 dated 17.01.2019 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 34, 354 IPC pertaining to Police Station Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar City and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands disposed off in those terms.
