The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of *Certiorari*, for setting aside the orders dated 26.09.2017 (**Annexures P-7 & P-8**), Tax Demand Notice dated 17.05.2018 (**Annexures P-9 & P-10**) along with notice dated 05.04.2019 (**Annexure P-11**) and letter of attachment of Bank account dated 11.04.2019 (**Annexure P-12**) qua the alleged recovery of Value Added Tax.

2. It was not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that alternative remedy against the revisional orders i.e. Annexures P-7 & P-8 is available. Accordingly, learned counsel submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy, by challenging Annexures P-7 & P-8, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
