Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for further custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has submitted that the petitioners and the complainant have entered into a settlement and he has no objection to the confirmation of the interim protection granted. However, an application has been filed by Gurdeep Singh for permitting intervention. Gurdeep Singh claims that he had purchased some property from Harbhajan Singh. At this stage, it would not be proper for this Court to adjudicate upon the rights of the parties particularly when civil litigation

is pending.

Keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the State and the complainant, the interim order dated 20.02.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
