Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to register the FIR on the basis of complaint (Annexure P-1) and complete the investigation expeditiously.

Reply on behalf of respondents No.5, 7 and 8 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Arun Kumar, submits that now the FIR has been registered on the complaint of the present petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as such.

It is clarified that from the stage of registration of the FIR, the police would proceed further in the matter in accordance with law. The respective parties shall also be entitled to take all the pleas in accordance with law. It is further clarified that, if the petitioner applies for any anticipatory bail, then it shall be considered in accordance with law without being influence by any observation of this Court.
