Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No. NACT-241 of 2016 dated 30.07.2016 filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act by the respondent as well as the summoning order dated 24.08.2016 and order framing charge dated 04.04.2018 alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy of discharge before learned trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

If an application for discharge is moved by the petitioner before the learned trial Court, the same shall be considered and decided as per law expeditiously, in view of the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Meters and Instruments Private Limited and another Vs. Kanchan Mehta**, (2018) 1 SCC 560.
