Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to perform their duties to protect life and liberty of the petitioners and ensure that petitioner is not implicated in any false case at behest of respondent No. 7 and to direct respondents No. 4 to 6 to issue atleast seven days advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner before registration of any case on the basis of complaint dated 05.02.2019 (P-8).

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Sudhir Taneja, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagadhri (Yamuna Nagar) on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3/State has already been filed.

Perusal of the reply reveals that there is no threat to the

life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.7.

Affidavit further reveals that police have inquired the matter honestly without favour of anyone.

In view of the stand taken by respondents No. 1 to 3/State, petitioner is not willing to pursue the matter any further at this stage.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter and the present petition is disposed off.

However, if the occasion so arises, petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court again.
