Petitioners Gagan Deep and Bijender have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of their life and liberty from the private respondents as they have entered into marriage against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the fact that the alleged marriage has been solemnized today itself at 8.00 AM and thereafter the representation (Annexure P-5) is sent to the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat today itself through a private courier service.

A perusal of the representation (Annexure P-5) reveals that the applicants have alleged that private respondents are trying to dissolve their marriage by illegal means. Since the marriage is performed today itself,

which is not in the knowledge of the private respondents, therefore, it is difficult to believe the stand of the petitioners that private respondents are trying to dissolve their alleged marriage. Not only this, the alleged representation is yet to reach the office of the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat. The petition has been filed hastily without disclosing a valid cause of action.

The contents of the petition do not inspire any confidence and no convincing ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to issue any direction to the official respondents.

The petition is hereby dismissed.
