AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 25.03.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No.21009 of 2014.

The only controversy surviving in the contempt petition is that interest @ 9% on delayed payment of pension, as ordered by this Court in CWP No.21009 of 2014, has not been paid.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Sunil Kumar Khosla, Legal Consultant, O/o Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Mohali, states that payment of interest has been made. He produced detail of calculation of amount, same

is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of statement made, contempt petition is disposed of.

However, it is clarified that if petitioners are aggrieved of calculation, they would be at liberty to make representation to the respondent alongwith detailed calculation. In case such representation is made, same would be decided by the respondent in accordance with law after providing opportunity of hearing. The needful shall be done expeditiously but not later than six weeks from receipt of the representation.
