Petitioners are present in person. On 22.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Manpreet Kaur and Gurdeep Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 and 5. They have placed on record photographs Annexures P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 20.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent no.2.

Mr. Ramdeep Pratap Singh, DAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 26.04.2019.”

Petitioners have submitted that now they do not have any threat to their life and liberty.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the State of Punjab has also submitted that respondent Nos.4 and 5 have accepted the marriage of the petitioners and have no objection and they have got recorded the statements to that effect.

A photocopy of the statements alongwith the report has been filed today in the Court, which is taken on record.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
