Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent No.4 as they have solemnized marriage on 07.04.2019 against the wishes of private respondent.

On 22.04.2019, State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat.

Learned State counsel has produced the affidavits of petitioners and statement of respondent No.4 (father of petitioner No.2). Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In the affidavits of petitioners, it is mentioned that they have no threat and they do not need any protection, whereas in statement of respondent No.4, it is clearly stated that he has no objection to the alleged marriage performed by the petitioners. This fact is not disputed by learned

counsel for

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the petitioners and he prays for withdrawal of the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
