Report dated 27.09.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Paramjit Singh, Arjun Gogna and Ram Lubhaya Gogna and complainant Sonia Johal, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and considering the fact that the offences for which the

accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 176 dated 10.09.2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar under Sections 67/67-A of Information Technology Act, 2008 and Section 354-C of IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
