Petitioner-Richa Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-16) whereby the trial Court allowed the application for release of passport of respondent No.2 permitting him to travel abroad and order dated 28.03.2019 (Annexure P-19) whereby trial Court released the passport even before the date of hearing fixed in the case.

During the course of arguments, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that pursuant to the impugned order, the respondent has availed the concession as granted by trial Court and has returned back to India. It is also not disputed by him that on the dates of hearing before the trial Court, the accused either appears in person or seeks

exemption from personal appearance. He further submits that the respondent is also present in the Court today.

In view of the above, it is apparent that the concession availed by the accused was not misused, therefore, this Court does not find any reason to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is dismissed.
