The instant writ petition was directed against the order dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-9) issued by the Director, PGIMER, Chandigarh and in terms of which the Surgical Gastroenterology Division, which was imparting super speciality training to M.Ch. students/petitioners had been dissolved/dismantled and thereby creating 4 separate units under the General Surgery Department.

On the previous date of hearing, a complete copy of the writ paper-book has been furnished to Mr. Amit Jhanji, standing counsel of PGIMER, Chandigarh, to complete instructions.

During the course of resumed hearing today, counsel for PGI, Chandigarh, submits that the impugned order dated 15.04.2019 has since been superseded and a fresh order dated 25.04.2019 has been passed.

The office order dated 25.04.2019 is in the following terms:-

OFFICE ORDER

In supersession to this office order Endst No.F.11012/E1(1)/PGI/2019 dated 15.04.2019 to streamline the functioning, ensure optimal utilization of space, help in enhancing the professional excellence and smooth functioning of the Department of General Surgery of this Institute, four separate functional units are hereby created in the Department with immediate effect. It will give coverage to more number of patients by the available consultants on various days of the week and appropriate administrative decision can be taken in the interest of patient care in the Department

Therefore, existing thirteen (13) faculty members in the Department of General Surgery are divided into four units as under:-

The posting of residents in different units will follow the existing pattern. Leave of residents must be forwarded to the head through the Unit Head. Vacations of faculty members will be decided after mutual consultation within the Unit. All Unit heads will exercise the routine day to day control over their Unit including recommendations of casual leave and station leave of faculty. The overall superintendence and control will be exercised by the HOD in all other administrative matters.

The HOD, General Surgery may work out the modalities to

divide OPD days, Day care OTs, Beds, Nehru Hospital Ots and any other items/issues amongst the four units after consulting with all the faculty members of the Department and send a proposal to the Director for consideration and approval.
