The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.163, dated 20.10.2018, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act and Sections 420, 482 of the IPC, at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press this petition. He further states that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and the same be directed to be decided expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed and it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on 15.5.2019 and moves an application for regular bail, the same

be decided in accordance with law expeditiously but in any case on or before 17.5.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
