Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.312 dated 08.12.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 307, 325 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

Affidavits of Senior Superintendent of Police, Jind as well as ASI Krishan Kumar, Investigation Officer, filed in the Court today, are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that in view of the aforesaid affidavits filed in the Court, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to petitioner Manoj @ Vinod to surrender before the trial Court and a direction may be issued to the trial Court to dispose of the regular bail application of the petitioner expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of three days from today, his regular bail application be decided within 03 days thereafter.

Since the present petition has been dismissed as withdrawn, no further action is called for in CRM-M-15637-2019, in which co-accused Ajmer was granted the concession of bail, as perusal of the order shows that the same was not granted exclusively on the basis of compromise and it was decided on merits of the case.
