Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 18.09.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Satwinder Singh. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that a number of litigations are pending between the petitioner and the deceased and there was no occasion to instigate the deceased to commit suicide.

The allegations of Section 306 IPC are matter of evidence, which shall be tested by the trial Court during trial.

Since the petitioner has joined investigation, interim order dated 18.09.2018 passed by this Court in his favour is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner is directed to join investigation, if required by the Investigating Officer.
