FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Pardeep Kumar in case bearing FIR No.0185 dated 08.06.2018 registered at Police Station Ambala City under Sections 323, 406, 498-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in consequence of the orders of interim bail dated 12.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mukesh, Police Station City Ambala who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute submitting further that the parties have effected a compromise and that cancellation report is being filed in the Court.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.09.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan).

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
