Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail pending trial in case FIR No. 8 dated 09.01.2015, under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 21/22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that almost entire prosecution evidence is over, therefore, instead of pressing the present petition on merits, he confines his prayer only to the extent that learned trial Court be directed to expedite the proceedings.

Prayer seems to be justified.

In view of the long custody of the petitioner, present petition is disposed off with directions to the learned trial Court to conclude the proceedings within two months from today.
