ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.

Prayer in this petition, filed through her husband Ajay, petitioner being minor, is for releasing the petitioner and her infant child from Nari Niketan/Ashram and to send them with husband of the petitioner namely Ajay, to join the matrimonial home.

While issuing notice of motion, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jind was directed to record statement of the petitioner, who was in custody of Chief Welfare Committee, Bhiwani and to send a report about welfare of the petitioner as well as her infant child. Thereafter, on request of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jind, time for recording the statement was extended and then the Chief Judicial Magistrate submitted a report, in which the petitioner has stated that she along with her minor son Aayush wants to stay with her

husband and mother-in-law Mala Devi. She has not any threat from her husband and in-laws and she do not want to stay with her father or brother.

The petitioner as well as her husband are present in the Court and the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for counselling of the petitioner and recording her statement. The petitioner has again made a statement that she is ready to join the company of her husband Ajay and the minor son Aayush is also in her custody and she want to withdraw this petition, as her husband Ajay is ready to take her and her son in matrimonial home.

Similar statement was made by her husband Ajay.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous. Petitioner is free to accompany her husband along with her minor child Aayush, to stay in her matrimonial home.
