Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.7 dated 07.04.2018 under Sections 376-D, 292, 34 IPC and Section 67-A of the Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Dhar Kanal, District Pathankot by constituting a special investigating team (SIT).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has submitted Challan on 06.03.2019. So far as accused Rohit @ Bablu is concerned, non-bailable warrants have been issued against him and necessary proceedings to declare him a

proclaimed-offender have been initiated, whereas other accused Harish Kumar has already been arrested. The investigation as regard the unknown person shown in the FIR is in process and as and when, his identity is carried out, the supplementary Challan would be presented.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is satisfied with the outcome of the investigation.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
