The petitioners Sukhwant Singh and Dhian Singh have approached this Court seeking appropriate directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass the petitioner No. 1 by forcefully entering Paramjit Kaur in his House No. 763, LIC Colony, Mundi Kharar, District Mohali of which petitioner No. 1 is owner in possession.

Notice of application (CRM-34191-2016) was issued on 27.10.2016 with further direction to maintain status quo with regard to the possession of the house. During the pendency of this petition, CRM-5011-2018 was filed for impleading Paramjit Kaur wife of Dhian Singh Kahlon as respondent No. 4. Vide order dated 30.04.2019, Mr. Swaran Sandhir, Advocate/Mediator has interacted with the parties and sought more time for mediation and parties were relegated to Mediation. As per report (Annexure A), parties have amicably resolved their issue on 31.05.2019 before the Mediation Centre and the compromise has been duly signed by

both the parties on 31.05.2019 and Dhian Singh and Sukhwant Singh have agreed to give Rs. 7 lacs to Harwant Kaur and Rs.12 lacs to Paramjit Kaur towards their entire claim regarding permanent alimony and maintenance for past, present and future shall stand settled. It is further agreed between the parties that Dhian Singh will not get the medical card cancelled and Paramjit Kaur or Harwant Kaur will not raise any bill of any medicine etc. against Dhian Singh Kahlon and nor Dhian Singh Kahlon shall be liable to pay any amount on medical treatment etc. The parties are bound by the terms of the compromise effected between the parties. They were duly represented by their counsel Mr. Ranjan Lakhan and Mr. Gautam Thapar. The compromise has been effected with the assistance of Mr. Swaran Singh, Mediator/Advocate.

Criminal miscellaneous petition stands disposed of keeping in view the compromise (Annexure A).

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
