Parties litigating are cousin brothers.

With the sincere efforts of learned counsels for the parties, parties have resolved their dispute and have agreed that the panchayati compromise arrived at on 24.05.2012 (Annexure A-2), which is part of the record, would be binding between both the parties and would have no objection, if the same is implemented by the revenue authorities.

This court has no doubt that the revenue authorities would get the settlement arrived at between the parties (panchayati compromise dated 24.05.2012) implemented in the revenue record within 2 months.

Learned counsel for the appellant-Jarnail Singh has expressed apprehension that there is some loan which has been taken by Ajit Singh-respondent herein by mortgaging a particular piece of land and his client

Jarnail Singh may not be required to pay that amount.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Ajit Singh, who is also present in Court has submitted that the charge by this order would get shifted to the piece of land which has been allocated to him pursuant to the aforesaid panchayati settlement dated 24.05.2012.

In view of the aforesaid settlement/panchayati compromise arrived at, the sincere efforts made by learned counsels for the parties are appreciable. The parties have also agreed that now they do not wish to proceed against each other. Their joint statement to that effect has been separately recorded.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, FIR No.129, dated 12.08.2015, registered under Sections 420/467/468/120-B IPC, at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, in totality and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are ordered to be quashed.
