GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.127 dated 24.07.2018 under Sections 279, 427, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 05.09.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Rakesh Kumar have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.127 dated 24.07.2018 under Sections 279, 427, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
