Petitioners Sajjan and Heena entered into marriage against the wishes of private respondents No.4 to 7 and apprehended threat at their hands. The petition was filed for seeking directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the private respondents.

On 6th September, 2018, notice of motion was issued and following order was passed :-

“Notice of motion for 30.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, respondent Nos.1 to 3 are directed to examine and consider the case of petitioners and if it is found that there is real and genuine threat to their life, limb and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7, then they will be provided protection

forthwith. If the situation so demands, the petitioners be also provided facility of Protection Home as per their requirement. However, this order shall not be applicable in case any act / conduct of any of the petitioners pertaining to the application, amounts to an offence.”

In compliance of the above order, a communication dated 05.10.2018 received from the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police, UT, Chandigarh, wherein, it is indicated that the statements of petitioners already stands recorded that at present they have no danger from anyone and residing peacefully at the place of residence. It is also mentioned that the petitioners do not want any police action.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition and the same is rendered infructuous.
