This application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for impleading legal representatives of petitioner Santokh Singh, who is stated to have died on 01.06.2018.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and does not object if legal representatives of petitioner Santokh Singh (deceased) is brought on record to pursue the petition.

The legal heirs of deceased-Santokh Singh as mentioned in para No.2 thereof, are impleaded as petitioners for the purpose of this petition only. Petitioner (deceased) had filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to hand over the investigation of case FIR No.30 dated 16.03.2016, under Sections 447, 511, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana to any independent agency.

During the course of hearing, learned State counsel has produced the order dated 02.11.2019 passed by the ld. JMIC, Ludhiana to contend that the untraced report already stands filed by the police and the complainant has expressed his disagreement for the same. It is pointed out that the case has been fixed for 01.02.2020 by the ld. JMIC, Ludhiana for filing protest petition.

Mr. Jaideep Singh, learned counsel for the petitioners does dispute this fact and states that the present petition is rendered infructuous.
