The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 411 dated 09.08.2018, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B, 34 and 406 of the IPC at Police Station Ratia.

The operative part of the order dated 12.09.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft of ₹ 2,65,000/- i.e. the half of the disputed amount to the Investigating Officer-SI Om Parkash. The draft be kept in safe custody with the Investigating Officer. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner be directed to join the investigation. List again on 29.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands compromised between the petitioner and complainant/respondent No. 2 and the same has been reduced in writing on 16.01.2019. A copy of the

said compromise is handed over to SI Randhir, who is present in Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Randhir, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also acknowledged that the matter stands compromised between the parties.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 12.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
