The grievance of the petitioner herein is that he has not been disbursed the arrears of salary arising out of his promotion with retrospective effect.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while similarly situated other employees have been given the said benefit, the petitioner has been unjustifiably denied the same. He also relies on the judgments rendered by this Court contained at Annexures P-6 & P-7(collectively). In the premise, the petitioner also caused a legal notice dated 23.12.2018 (Annexure P-9) which was not adverted by the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anu Chatrath, Sr. Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG Punjab puts in appearance on behalf of respondents-State.

Given the nature of order being passed and keeping in view the aforesaid, no further proceedings or pleadings are warranted in this case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to respondents to pass a

speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the legal notice dated 23.12.2018(Annexure P-9) along with the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation as also keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners, noted above, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits, as claimed by him, the same be accorded to him within a period of two months thereafter.
