Pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2019, learned State counsel has taken instructions to the effect that though the vehicle stated to be involved in the commission of an offence stands registered in the name of Aman Kapoor, however, on March 08, 2019, the petitioner executed an affidavit to the effect that he had purchased it, with the FIR seen to be dated March 20, 2019.

Be that as it may, learned State counsel on instructions from a police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2019 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.
