Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to learned trial Court to expedite the proceedings, resulting out of Complaint No.8707 dated 24.07.2017 (**P-1**), under Section 138 read with Section 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (*for short 'Act'*) in view of the provisions of Section 143 (3) of the Act.

Contentends that matter is being unnecessarily lingered on before the learned trial Court at the instance of respondents and reference in this regard is made to certain zimni orders (**P-5** colly.), attached with the paper-book.

Without making any observation against the respondents, but keeping in view the zimni orders (**P-5** colly.), this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the present petition with the request to learned trial Court to proceed in the matter expeditiously and to decide the same preferably within six months from the receipt of certified copy of this order if there is no legal impediment.

Ordered accordingly.
