Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.363 dated 06.07.2016 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 469, 471, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ghraunda, District Karnal.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 25.04.2019: -

“.....As per averments made in the petition, the petitioner is neither signatory nor beneficiary of the agreement to sell. The petitioner has relied upon the order dated 24.08.2016 passed in CRM-M-28151-2016 filed by co-accused Sanjay Singh, wherein he was granted the concession of interim bail, which was later on confirmed on 21.12.2017.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajender Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
