As per pleadings on record petitioner pursued the three years LL.B. Course in a private institute affiliated to the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. Petitioner secured the LL.B. degree in the year 2018.

Instant writ petition was filed seeking a mandamus to direct the respondent-University to follow the stipulation contained in the University Calendar as also follow past practice and to award the petitioner the gold medal on account of having secured the maximum number of marks combined in all the six semesters of the LL.B. Course.

Mr. Rahul Sharma, learned counsel during the course of hearing today informs the Court that after filing of the writ petition, respondent-University has proceeded further in the matter and has now awarded a gold medal to the candidate based on performance/marks secured in the 5th and 6th Semesters alone.

Under such circumstances, withdrawal of the instant writ petition is sought with liberty to file a petition afresh so as to press for the prayers made in the instant petition as also to raise a challenge to the award

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of the Gold Medal to another candidate.

Prayer is allowed.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Pending application (s) if any, shall also stand disposed of.
