Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.34 dated 28.01.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2019, the petitioners who are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the complainant have joined the investigations. He further states that in view of the order dated 26.09.2019 passed by this Court, Bal Krishan (husband) and Kalpna (complainant) are staying together as husband and wife.

Learned counsel for the complainant, however, states that

conduct of the parties may be watched for some more time.

Heard.

In view of the fact that the parties i.e. Bal Krishan (petitioner in CRM-M-19987-2019) and Kalpna (complainant) are staying together as husband and wife and petitioners being in-laws of the complainant, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.04.2019 is, hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
