Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing of the order dated 22.08.2016 passed by learned Judicial
Magistrate First Class, Patiala (P-2) vide which the petitioner has
declared proclaimed person.

It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the
petitioner that in terms of the order dated 06.09.2018, the petitioner
has jointed the proceedings before learned trial Court.

On instructions from ASI Sham Lal, learned State
counsel has duly acknowledged the above factual position.

Since the petitioner has joined the proceedings before
learned trial Court, therefore there is no justification to continue with
the recourse under Sections 83 as well as 446 of Cr.P.C.
Consequently impugned order dated 22.08.2016 to that effect is
quashed and set aside.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to learned trial Court to proceed in the matter expeditiously.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with proceedings and would not commit any recurrence in future.

Ordered accordingly.
