Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.44 dated 30.06.2011 under Sections 419, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 420 & 511 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station, Mullanpur Gariabdas (SAS Nagar) (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 21.03.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Case is stated to be pending trial.

In compliance to the order dated 29.11.2018, report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar has been received that the parties have been entered into compromise which is without any pressure, undue influence, force or threat. The case was registered on the complaint of respondent No.2/complainant-Naib Singh.

Since the parties have effected compromise and it was primarily

dispute regarding agreement of sale, the continuation of further proceedings before the trial Court will be a useless exercise.

Accordingly, FIR No.44 dated 30.06.2011 under Sections 419, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 420 & 511 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station, Mullanpur Gariabdas (SAS Nagar) (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioner.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
