The present contempt petition has been filed stating that there is violation of interim order dated 22.1.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-2445 of 2018. The said order is reproduced below:

“Notice of motion for 22.3.2018.

In the meantime, Director General of Police, Punjab is directed to form a Special Investigating Team headed by an officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police and complete the investigation at the earliest and submit the status report in this Court.

Meanwhile, Baljit Singh petitioner and his family members be also provided protection to their life, limb and liberty.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Jaswinder Singh, states that Special Investigation Team was constituted,

headed by Mr. Parikh, IPS. The Special Investigation Team has submitted its report and petitioner-Baljit Singh and his family members have been provided protection.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the statement made by learned counsel for the State.

As the main petition itself is pending and the interim order *prima facie* has been complied with, no further orders are called for in the present petition.

The Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.

In case the petitioner still has any grievance with regard to compliance of the interim order dated 22.1.2018, he would be at liberty to take said plea in the main petition.
