The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 19.12.2018 passed in CWP No. 37615 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notices dated 15.09.2018 and 28.09.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) respectively, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notices dated 15.09.2018 and 28.09.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) respectively, within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notices, the same should also be paid to the petitioners within three months thereafter."

A speaking order has been produced today in Court, copy handed over to counsel for petitioners.

As per the order dated 22.8.2019, the claim of the petitioners has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that liberty be granted to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 22.8.2019.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
